This preceptorship award aims to recognize and support early career physicians or advanced practice providers with an interest in clinical aspects of functional gastrointestinal (GI) and motility disorders. It is intended to promote career growth through in-person interaction at a medical center with expertise in these disorders. This opportunity will allow for learning about clinical operations, observation in clinic and motility laboratories, and networking with clinicians who are experts in the field. Each award consists of up to \$5,000 to cover expenses related to working at the visited medical center, travel, food and beverage and accommodation.

6. **Letter of Invitation:** The letter of invitation from the host at the indicated institution to be visited should include areas of synergy in research with the applicant along with activities they will offer if awarded.
7. **Curriculum Vitae of the Applicant/Nominee:** (including degrees held, the years they were awarded, and the institutions that awarded them.). *Please attach.*
