2026 IFFGD Travel Awards Application Form

These travel awards are intended to encourage the participation of young clinicians and scientists in multidisciplinary efforts aimed at advancing the understanding of functional gastrointestinal and motility disorders, and neurogastroenterology. To be eligible, the investigator must have completed their highest level of training no more than seven years prior to nomination/application. They should have demonstrated a record of accomplishment, and be currently active in investigating basic, translational or clinical aspects of functional GI or motility disorders, or other neurogastroenterology topics.

Awards will be presented to all those who serve the IFFGD patient community. This includes gastroenterologist (MD), basic science researchers (PhD), Advanced Care Providers (PA and FNP) and other healthcare professionals (dietitians, psychologists, physical therapists, etc.). There will also be awards for trainees (medical students and fellows), those from underrepresented communities and smaller GI programs. This includes people of color and those who work at institutions that do not have internationally recognized programs in the IFFGD portfolio. This will include smaller Functional GI and Motility labs and rare GI disorders (even if the institution as a whole has a large GI program).
